TOPIC 1: THE IMPORTANCE OF ESTABLISHING A RELIABILITY CULTURE IN AN ORGANIZATION

identified that could cause business consequence with all being monitored by the Reliability Software system. In the last 12 months 40% of equipment abnormalities that went into alarm were fixed during inspection, 10% fixed during planned outages and the remainder being monitored relative to pre-defined risk limits. The goal is to get to a point where over 2 million failure modes will be monitored with risk mitigation actions in place to avoid business consequence.
